# **Executive Director's Report**

- Scheduling complete for Classic and Academy fall programs.
- Game Cards: East Central will be following the same rules as WYSA concerning game cards. East Central thinks there will be less confusion at the field if we are following the same guidelines.
  - o Game cards (printed in color) are expected at all East Central Games
  - o If the coach does not have an East Central Game Card, referees will accept, in a pinch; East Central roster or WYSA roster. Only players on one of the three documents will be allowed to play. The game will be played but the referee will note that a game card was not presented, and the club will be contacted.
  - o It was determined that no fines will be issued this fall for missing game cards while the clubs adjust to the new scheduling software this fall.
- Coaches that may be on the coaching side of the field and are not listed on the game card must present their coach pass card to the referee at check-in.
  - O How to print a Coach pass card: Go to the roster on the WYSA side and click more actions on top right. Click print member cards, Click select members, and you can select the coach.
- At this point, the only teams that need player pass cards are E64 teams or tournaments requiring them. No teams in East Central will need player pass cards.

### • League Chairperson

- O The competition committee had more appeals this year as teams would request level 2 but because East Central League did not have enough teams to have both a classic 1 and classic 2 division. The teams were concerned that they would not be able to compete at a classic 1 level. Brian indicated that really the division is playing at more of a 1.5 classic level.
  - A lengthy discussion on ways to keep good competition in the district rather than seeing teams go to state league and play neighboring clubs that they could have stayed in the district to play. Clubs/parents could avoid all the travel and expense of state league.
    - Issues are that parents like the idea of fancy league titles and chase that dream.
    - While other parents do not want to travel so they have their kids do other things
- o It was determined that we should talk to clubs in our area to propose that clubs stay in the district to play another season before going to state league. Especially if the league already has a good competition level. Good discussion among the clubs is needed to get this accomplished.
  - Have a discussion at the end of Fall games and early in June to see if teams would commit to stay in the East Central League especially if a good competitive league was present in the prior season.
- O Some members think that many teams playing state league is just the way things are now, and you cannot change the environment.
  - If clubs do not offer the state league division as an option, the players will just go to another club to play in the state league.
- **Games** East Central games are starting this week.
