Vice-President's Report – Jeff Pozniak

We've just hired a new person for the role of Director of Operations - Melissa Pierson. A few details:

She lives in the Fox Cities

She played soccer in college

She has 2 kids that both play soccer, 1 in rec, 1 in competitive

She coaches soccer

She currently is the Chief of Staff of Soccer Parenting (you probably are familiar with Skye Eddy's work as the President)

She has a STEM degree

She has extensive experience with systems, including soccer systems and possibly more importantly AI. It appears her work with AI may make a big impact on streamlining the scheduling process for the district.

I asked her not to attend this meeting because I wanted to set the stage for the evolution of the district and this position within the district.

Maybe first and foremost it would be helpful for clubs to think of this role and the district as a resource that focuses on teaching someone to fish versus giving someone a fish.

What do I mean by this? If you're a club that struggles to keep up with the administrative tasks involved in managing the club, maybe you have a few people doing most of the work and when those folks are on vacation or otherwise can't be available things fall through the cracks – if you're in this situation, reach out to me or someone else in the district so we can help you solve a staffing issue. WE WANT YOU TO SUCCEED.

The flip side of this – emergencies happen, and the district can be there to help you get through a tight spot. But this Dir of Ops is a part time position, and though I don't intend to speak for Melissa, clubs should not expect that a text or call late at night gets answered until the next morning, so plan accordingly.

The district can provide some help in working through Playmetrics issues and even direct the club to Playmetrics itself for additional help if the district can't solve it, but a club shouldn't expect that the district QA check your rosters or provide regular assistance on administrative tasks that would normally fall on the club.

I know Justin is working on plans to grow and improve the district, I have some ideas myself, and I expect Melissa will in time too. A healthy, robust district is built with many healthy clubs, big and small. To do that Melissa's role, as well as Justin's and perhaps mine need to give more attention to program offerings, revenue growth, and the Dir of Ops role nudge away from administrative assistant and toward it's named title.

I say all that to share this - things will be different with this new role. The soccer landscape is evolving and to grow and improve we need to evolve, too.
