Meeting call to order at 9:00 AM East Central has 34 voting members - (17) Quorum is the minimum number of members that must be present at the meeting to make the proceedings valid.

Introduction:

Approval of Minutes

• 2024 October All Club Board Meeting Minutes

Motion to approve the 2024 October All Club Board Meeting Minutes made by Mike Jones (East Central Referee Commissioner) and seconded by Brian Casey (East Central League Chairperson).

Motion passed.

Elections President – Two-year term

- Justin Oshefsky was elected East Central President by acclimation.
- Secretary Two-year term
 - No nominations for the Secretary position. It was decided that a write-up on what the position entails would be sent out to the membership to see if someone would be interested in the position.

Discussion: Vicki King agreed to stay until a new Secretary could be found.

Motion to nominate Vicki King as Secretary until a permanent person could be found for the Secretary position. Motion made by Jeff Jones (Synergy) and seconded by Matt Walters (River Surge)

Motion passed.

President's Report:

Age Change possibility for Fall 2026 and beyond - US Youth Soccer has decided not to make any changes to the age brackets but have indicated that next fall clubs/districts may change to school year age groups if they wish. It's been brought up in conversation on whether the district would entertain that change. There are of course many obstacles and issues that would come up if the district changed but the state and regions did not. I thought at this time a discussion amongst the group would be appropriate.

Discussion: Membership discussed their concern over the age change of divisions.

- Smaller clubs wanted to go back to school year calendar brackets.
- It was felt that it was painful when there was a movement from the school year age bracket to a calendar year. Making that move back to the school age bracket would hurt teams that have been playing together for a long time.
- Tournaments outside the district would present an issue for clubs to produce a team roster at the correct age.
- Fifi runs their programs under a calendar year.
- East Central will do what WYSA does.
 - There will be a discussion about this topic at WYSA AGM.

Club cooperation with trapped 8th graders - Our district clubs vary a great deal in size and each year the number of 'trapped' 8th graders (boys in fall and girls in spring) also varies from club to club. This past fall we had two clubs working together to place a team, Scott worked with Electric City years ago in the same way as well. At the same time, we have had some players in clubs not get to play in a season due to low numbers. Do we want to look at a process that would make it easier for clubs to combine players into teams so that the kids

can participate and compete while their club teammates are away at high school soccer? Currently our only means to make this work is by dropping kids from one club and moving them temporarily to another, but there is likely an easier way if everyone can come to a consensus. If there is interest in this path, we can discuss it now and hopefully work out a process for it to be ready by fall of 2025.

Discussion: Membership discussed making sure we have teams at the right level of play

- Placing teams in different divisions.
 - o If a team should be placed in a lower division the club should explain why they want a different placement. East Central looks at the age of team and past playing history.
- Is there a way to make it easier for two clubs to create an 8th grade team so that the players can find a team to play on?
 - Currently clubs are dropping players and registering them to another club to make a team. Then moving the players back after the season.

- · Thursday, February 27, 2025– Appeals have been satisfied, and scheduling begins.
- · Thursday, February 27- March 6, 2025 Schedule with date assignments sent to clubs. Clubs will work to put fields and times into the schedule. Keep traveling teams in mind when assigning times.

Thursday March 13, 2025, at noon. Any game that does not have a field and time assignment will lose their home game and it will be assigned to the traveling team. This club will also be put in bad standing. See rules about bad standing on the East Central website.

Thursday, March 6-27, 2025 – Clubs can collaborate with each other to adjust dates changes.

• WYSA- State Rep Report-Dusty Rhodes

- We will revisit the girl's tryout dates in January, and I expect the tryout policy will be amended to push that group back.
- We are waiting for USYS and US Soccer to share more about player registration. The 2025/2026 season will continue to register players by birth year. Organization members will have discretion in 2026/2027, but no decision has been made for USYS yet. We expect to know more about it the week of the WYSA AGM
 - 2025 WYSA AGM will be March 8 at American Family Field with Hall of Fame Ceremony in the evening
 - Wisconsin will hold a C and B license in 2025
- The Women in Sport Symposium is taking place in Brookfield Conference Center on February 22, 2025

TOPSoccer-Jeff Jones

- FIRE SOCCER: Wausau/Point had 14 players in fall and now a new session is open for February Sunday mornings. Howard/Suamico: had 10 players for the November session and will have a session February-March at Purdy. (submitted by Armando Martinez)
- Oshkosh United: Jim Jungwirth is now coordinating the program in conjunction with the YMCA.
 Currently active with 20 players running 6 Saturdays from Jan 11 through Feb 15.
- Kimberly/RSSC: Kimberly TOPS soccer has started its winter/spring season. It will run in Jan/Feb and April. We have over 25 kids in our program and are growing. Thanks to Lawerence soccer teams and Riveredge, we have plenty of volunteers. (submitted by Jane McCormick)

The Penalties Matrix defines consequences associated with physical and non-physical offenses against Referees.

KEY PENALTY FACTORS

- Single offenses are at minimum the prescribed game penalty or time penalty for non red zone offenses
- Penalties can be both game and time depending on severity / circumstances
- Second time offenders receive double punishment
- Third time offenders receive a lifetime ban
- More than one offense at the same time is at least the punishment for the most serious offense.
- Offenses against minors are automatically subject to a "minor multiplier" resulting in triple punishment
- One offense warning per league to be managed by states and leagues collaboratively
- Game consequences are inclusive of 1 game penalty for any red cards given
- Optionality for 50% penalty for first offense from a minor



• League Chairperson - Brian Casey

- o League adjustments to keep teams in East Central longer
- O The following teams and playing records were shared to the membership as a discussion point. You will see that many of the same teams played in East Central and then decided to play in the State League. East Central would like to retain these teams in the district longer so that the teams will not have to pay high state league prices and will not have to travel great distances to play games.
 - One issue is that the team applications for WYSA and for East Central are at different times.
 - It is felt that we need some type of gate keeper to make sure that the right teams are moving up to the State League.
- East Central would like to open a discussions with Portage and Wisconsin Rapids to see if they
 would like to guest play in our district. Brian Casey will reach out to these clubs to see if we can
 work out an agreement to help retain teams in our district longer.
