



# “4 Corner Score”

*East Central Soccer District Academy Curriculum*

**Curriculum Topic:** Passing & Receiving

**Primary Objective:** To improve field vision, communication and team play w/ an activity that fosters creativity

**Duration:** 10 minutes

The Basics		<p><b>Organization</b> 30yd x 30yd grid with 6yd squares marked by cones at each corner.</p> <p>Group divided into 2 teams (w/ pinnies).</p> <p>1 ball.</p>
	<p><b>Activity</b> Teams play within the grid and score 1 pt by: 1) Making 4 consecutive passes, 2) Dribbling into any corner, 3) Passing to a teammate in the corner. Score 3 pts by: 1) Passing to a teammate not yet in a corner (leading pass).</p> <p>A player inside a square corner possessing the ball is safe and cannot be challenged for the ball.</p> <p>“Make it/take it” format; team that scores continues with possession of the ball trying to score into another corner or make another string of consecutive passes.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This is a great activity for fostering communication, so encourage players off the ball to call for a pass to a corner, and for the dribbler to direct where she wants teammates to go to receive a pass.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If both teams struggle to score, or a good portion of the players aren’t actively involved in the play, add a 2<sup>nd</sup> ball.</li> </ul>
